Specific job tasks will be delineated in collaboration with assigned RTA Principals as assigned. *Changing the scope of work or deviating from any other part of the agreed upon direction of the digital design and/or BIM requirements requires prior approval from a Principal.*

Qualified applicants must have:

- Bachelor's or Master's Degree of Architecture.
- State of Colorado Architectural License.
- Minimum five (5) years architecture and design visualization experience.
- Superior communication skills to facilitate understanding of RTA digital design tools and BIM implementation.
- Creative thinking ability and excellent problem-solving skills.
- Experience with governmental agencies regarding building codes and zoning ordinances.
- Required skills: deep knowledge of the BIM process and supporting Autodesk Revit, communication, leadership, planning, teamwork, decision-making, judgment, and problem-solving associated with all phases of a project.
- Experience with architectural visualization techniques. Required computer skills include Revit, AutoCAD, Adobe Creative Suite, and MS Office. Experience with Dynamo scripting, Bluebeam, and other Autodesk software is a plus.
- Ability to perform work which requires the consistent exercise of discretion and judgment in its performance.

Typical work hours are 8 am – 5 pm, Monday – Friday. Flexible options may be available based on job responsibility and leadership expectations. Salary dependent upon experience and skills, plus benefits.
